

Our Faculty...



Dr. Steven Bongard obtained his DDS degree from the University of Toronto Faculty of Dentistry in 1986. His professional interest has been concentrated on all aspects of implant dentistry since 1995. He has extensive experience in implant placement, bone grafting procedures as well as the prosthetic component of implant restoration. He has published and lectured both nationally and internationally on implant placement, full arch rehabilitation and non-grafted immediate approaches to implant surgery. He presently maintains a dental practice in Toronto, Ontario that is exclusive to the placement and restoration of dental implants. His recent focus has been on developing a community resource and training centre that can provide access to innovation, technology and advanced infrastructure, as well as support and mentoring, to the dental implant community.



Dr. Brian Freund did his medical training at McMaster University and received his dental and specialist training at the University of Toronto. He practices Oral and Maxillofacial surgery at the Chrysalis Dental Centre in Toronto limited to immediately loaded implant rehabilitation, neuromuscular dysfunction and minimally invasive facial rejuvenation. He is a director of the Canadian Society for Neurotoxins in Pain and the Pinnacle Academy of Learning. He was previously an examiner for the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario and the Royal College of Dentists of Canada. His area of research is focused on the novel applications of neuromodulators in the head and neck. He has lectured extensively nationally and internationally as well as authored numerous scientific papers.

Saunders textbook "Endosseous Implants in the Maxillofacial Reconstruction." He has lectured in North America and abroad. He is past president of the Canadian Association of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgeons, past President of the Academy of Osseointegration Foundation and has Fellowship status in the Academy of Osseointegration.
